

GENESIS

This is a transcription of a study by Pastor Arnold Murray. Most have never heard this teaching - but if you will use a King James Bible and a Strong's Concordance to verify - you will find out that it is in fact - TRUE! The scripture is in bold print and his comments are in *italic print*. Enjoy this fascinating look at the beginning...

Genesis is a Greek word meaning 'creation' and 'from the beginning'. Actually, it started with the Septuagint. It covers 'in the beginning'. Now, as we cover this, I want you to think to yourself - 'when was the beginning?' That's very important. We have many channels of thought in this direction of how old the earth is. We have many reports from the scientific community, we have some from the unlearned religious community, and we have some from the religious community that are pretty much right on. I trust that we fall into this category. With that having been said, Genesis has many likenesses to the Apocalypse, which is to say the Book of Revelation. Satan fell in the first chapter of Genesis and he's kicked out of heaven in chapter 12 of the Book of Revelation. The tree of life is taken away from man in the Book of Genesis and given back in the Book of Revelation. The earth became chaotic in the Book of Genesis and made anew in the Book of Revelation. We can almost teach the Book of Revelation from the Book of Genesis. If you were to use God's record and understand as we go why God does things. Why did He destroy the first earth age? And that's why you must be aware of that first earth age - and we will document it probably in this first lecture. You will understand that there was an earth age before this one. That's why anyone in science or anyone that has an eye to study archaeology or geology can tell you how old this earth is. It's millions of years old. And God's Word declares that it is - there's no argument there with a learned person. So, with that having been said, let's get right into it. Genesis - in the beginning - Chapter 1 verse 1...and it reads:

Genesis 1:1 *"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth." He created both heaven and earth. Period! Did it say when? Of course, it did not. It simply states that in the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. I want to do something - who was with God when He accomplished this? We find this out in the Book of Proverbs, 8th chapter. This is wisdom speaking. Wisdom was with the Father at that time. We'll take a little time, so that you understand this and follow along. **Proverbs 8:22** "The LORD possessed me in the beginning of His way, (in the beginning) before His works of old." Which is to say in the first earth age. Wisdom was with Him. Why? Because all wisdom flows from God. **8:23** "I was set up from*

everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.” *Before the earth was even formed...even in the first earth age....I was with Him. Wisdom was.* **8:24** “When there were no depths (no ocean), I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water.” *Wisdom was with the Father.* **8:25** “Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth.” *I was here!* **8:26** “While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.” *This means the least little atom. Why did I cover these verses? Because I want you to see that many things are mentioned in God’s Word that mentions this very subject. And people are simply not aware of them. Now, do you think God ever created anything in chaos? Do you think God ever created something bad? The answer to that is NO. Why? Because wisdom was with Him...before the first stone of this world was formed. And wisdom does not agree with chaos. How did chaos come about then? Let’s read and understand...*

Genesis 1:2 “And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved (*I repeat - moved...*) upon the face of the waters.” *This would be hard to understand if you don’t know a little about the Hebrew manuscripts. This would read as though God created it void and without form (my note - I can’t understand the Hebrew word he mentions here). The truth hinges on the word ‘was’. This is not correct, actually. Here is the Hebrew word for ‘was’ - Strong’s #1961 - hayah ‘a primitive root of ‘to exist or become’...‘come to pass’. In other words, the earth wasn’t created void and without form - it ‘became’ void and without form. When? When Satan rebelled. When a third of God’s children began to follow Satan. There was turmoil, and God did destroy that first earth age and brought in this present earth age. So, what you’re talking about is the overthrow of Satan’s power (spoken of in Ezekiel 28 of how he was actually an archangel that was supposed to cover the mercy seat as was written in that 28th chapter of Ezekiel.) He began to take pride within himself and began to have the children of God worship him instead of God. Because of one thing - pride! Pride within himself. It’s important that you know the earth wasn’t created that way...but BECAME void and without form. Why? God destroyed that that was. And it is written, and I’ll be glad to document that for you.*

Let’s go if we may to the great prophet Isaiah and read of this. It was without form - absolute chaos. Meaning there is nothing. Listen carefully. **Isaiah 45:18** “For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; (*what? He formed it and He made it*) he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: (*Not to be destroyed. He formed it. He made it. To be inhabited by who? His children*) **I am the LORD; and there is none else.**” *Here is one documentation that the earth was not created without form. Was not created void. He created it beautiful. This is why from the world that was that we can*

find mammoths in the tundra - ice in Alaska. Still with buttercups (near the North Pole) in their mouths. Lush lagoons even in that part of the world. That's why we can find palm trees at the poles. The petrified woods that are left behind documenting that it was a beautiful time. It was a beautiful place. Until the earth became void and without form. God destroyed it - but it wasn't the way He created it. He created it to be inhabited - and then it became that way. God continues to speak... 45:19 "I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right." So, if God declares things that are right, why should there be dissension and disputes. All you have to do is clearly listen to what the Father says. He did not create the earth in a chaotic form. It became that way because of Satan's rebellion. And we'll document it even further.

Let's go to the New Testament. Let's see what the New Testament has to say when you have the ability to think for a moment and leave off the traditions of men...and let God speak to you. He doesn't hide the truth. It isn't hidden - you just read it for yourself. Just take a moment to check it out. In II Peter, chapter 3, He tells you to be very careful, because in the end times, there will be people (scoffers) come along saying 'it's not gonna happen. That is to say God's return. And then he begins to tell us about the plan of God. Of the earth ages and the heaven ages. Not different earths or different heavens - same earth - same heaven - but different ages. Like the world that was of old, which God had to destroy. And the remnants of that destruction are obvious. I personally do not understand how someone can take a drive through the petrified forest in this great nation and not realize that an upheaval from the earth age that was - when you see those giant pines turned to rock because of the ages gone by. And many other places that we discover. Let's read about the different earth ages... 2 Peter 3:5 "For this they (the scoffers) willingly are ignorant of, (now, I didn't call them ignorant - God did) that by the Word of God (by what? By some man? NO - By the Word of God) the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:" Not created under it - but created it so the earth could be inhabited. The flood of the overthrow - not Noah's flood (put Noah's flood out of your mind for now). I don't want you to be ignorant of it - I want you to read in God's Word what happened. 3:6 "Whereby the world that then was (the first earth age), being overflowed with water, perished:" Do yourself a favor and look up this word 'perished' in the Greek and find out that it also means 'void and without form' in a sense because it means 'nothingness'. This doesn't give any way for some man with a family to be floating around on a boat or an ark. I mean there were no pigeons or doves. It perished - finis! Period. Void and without form. Totally - thats why, again, a scientist can document that this earth is millions of years old. Why? Because it is!! God's Word declares it - it was of old. Then some Bible thumper will come along saying his bible says the earth is only

6,000 years old - Well, he shows his ignorance concerning the manuscripts and the simple Word of God. Simply by listening to men's traditions and their fear of digging into God's Word. They repeat the same sermons of salvation and baptism over and over - to people that are saved and baptized. There's a place for these sermons - but after salvation and baptism, they need to teach people what the Word of God really says...whereby they are no longer ignorant...Biblically illiterate...of events that have transpired where they cannot with credibility discuss with an educated person in the sciences - the Word of God. That's important. So, He destroyed it. It's written right here in the New Testament.

II Peter 3:7 ***"But the heavens and the earth, which are now (this would be in Peter's time and even unto this day), by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition (here's that word 'perish' again) of ungodly men."*** Perdition means to come to nothing - nada. To perish. It didn't say those that followed God...but ungodly men. The rudiments are evil things of this world that will be destroyed by fire. And what is that fire? If you would look in the Book of Hebrews and read the final verse of chapter 12, you would find that God is a consuming fire. Which is to say that if He can simply speak and nothing became everything...He can also speak and that consuming fire would cause to perish that which is evil. Listen carefully beloved....

II Peter 3:8 ***"But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day."*** In other words, if we say that God replenished or recreated the governments - the peoples that are here in seven days of God's time, how long would that be? He said 'I don't want you to be ignorant about this'...A day with the Lord is a thousand years....a millennium. Then you should know what a millennium is then The Lord's Day, which is yet coming. But time wise, 7 days with Him is 7,000 years. When you're figuring it from His standpoint. Some men, when something is found that was from 13,000 years ago - they almost lose their faith. Why? Don't let your ignorance overload your donkey. A little knowledge can be a dangerous thing. So think and use your head. God pleads with you to not be ignorant concerning these things.

II Peter 3:9 ***"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; (He's not forgetful) but is longsuffering to us-ward, (He has much patience) not willing that any should perish, (He doesn't want that to happen to anyone) but that all should come to repentance."*** They won't, though. But, it's God's will that they would. He's given them every opportunity. He isn't looking for someone, or some group to 'zap'...He made salvation available to one and all...whosoever will!

II Peter 3:10 “But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be **burned up.**” *Check out the word ‘elements’. It means ‘rudiments’, which means only the evil part will be destroyed. Only that which is good will be left behind. In other words, the Holy Spirit touches your heart and it warms you...but the Holy Spirit will utterly destroy Satan and those that choose to follow him. And that, quite frankly, brings in the Lord’s Day, which is the Millennium, a 1,000 year period. Again, let’s analyze...it is not God’s will that anybody go to hell...perish...the lake of fire. It’s not His will. He is very patient and the figure of speech ‘a thief in the night’ simply means no one is going to be expecting Him. Going back to the fact that there will be scoffers saying it’s not going to happen...everything is the same as from the beginning...but most people don’t even know when the beginning was! So let them scoff...but don’t you be ignorant of the fact that the world that was of old was destroyed by water. There was no olive branch to bring back after that happened. (If you think Noah’s time was what was being spoken of here). There were no birds left and certainly there was no man left as it is written. Where is it written? In God’s Word...haven’t you ever read it? It’s written very plainly in the 4th chapter of the great prophet Jeremiah. Let’s go there...let’s document these things whereby you are brought into knowledge. Because God didn’t hide these things under a rock. He didn’t speak from some hidden place to keep it a big secret. It’s here if you wish to absorb it. Whereby you are not ignorant of how things are. I’m not saying this to put anyone down - but I’m saying it to wake you up to the truth and to absorb the wisdom that your Father has so graciously given you in this Word - and by this Word these things were done. Let me fix the place here! God had been threatening to a degree. In a sense, what He’s doing here is saying “Hey, you had better take that threat seriously because I did destroy it once before, and if you don’t think I will do it again - try me! Basically, that’s the thought our Father has in mind...”*

Jeremiah 4:22 “For my people is foolish, they have not known me; they are **sottish children** (*this means they are stupid children*), and they have none **understanding**: (*they do not have that wisdom nor do they seek it*) **they are wise to do evil** (*they know the ways of the world - how to skim their brother before he skims them*), **but to do good they have no knowledge.**” *None at all. And in many of the so-called houses of God, is the truth really taught there? As to what happened in the beginning? Well, you can judge that because I’m sure you’ve been to a lot of them. Is it or isn’t it? I’ll let you answer this for yourself.*

Jeremiah 4:23 “**I beheld the earth** (*now, I want you to see through His eyes*), **and, lo, it was without form, and void; and the heavens, they had no light.**” *This is after the over-throw. He’s gonna tell you how He shook it up. How He destroyed it.*

Jeremiah 4:24 “I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly.” *I put my hands on them - I shook it up.* **4:25** “I beheld (I looked), and, lo, there was no man (I destroyed them totally and completely off the earth. No Noah floating around in case you’re thinking the flood of Noah. Forget it. We’re talking about before man was created in the flesh. There was no man left on earth, that is to say Sons of God, they were removed. Why? Because it had gone corrupt and God destroyed it) **and all the birds of the heavens were fled.**” They were gone - perished. None left - not a one. Let me make a statement. You have seen and observed in many places species of birds found in the fossilized form that don’t exist anymore. And I assure you, there is not one species today from the earth of old that carried over. They all died. God re-created, yes...and there is a likeness. And we find results of this over-throw in the earth today.

Jeremiah 4:26 “I beheld, and, lo, the fruitful place was a wilderness, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the LORD, and by His fierce anger.” *The wrath of God! Yes, there were cities. Where are they? Well, lest I go into dimensions - but for those that know - think along that line. In the dimension of spiritual bodies, sometimes it’s difficult for us in the flesh body to understand. But, there were cities and they were destroyed. Nothing left...period!*

Jeremiah 4:27 “For thus hath the LORD said, The whole land shall be desolate; yet I will not make a full end.” *And He didn’t. He did as He said in the first Book of Genesis. So, what can we summarize from this? There was very clearly an earth age before this one. That’s why we find fossils and the remains. There’s no getting around it. (He shows a mammoth tooth...10 million years old). These things have to be explained - they’re here. And it turns many young people away from Christianity because there is no explanation. Many of them will say, ‘show me a dinosaur in the Bible’. It’s here...known in the Book of Job as the behemoth. The behemoth grazed on the mountain tops - not in a river bed. He had a tail as big as a cedar tree. This is only one of God’s creations that has a tail like that, other than a whale - but a whale doesn’t live on top of the mountains. This is a dinosaur. And in that particular part of Job, God is talking about that first earth age, the age He had to destroy. Why would God destroy something that beautiful? Because of Satan. He drew a third of God’s children away from Him. God had a choice. He could have destroyed the children and Satan right then, but He is longsuffering. This means He’s very patient with His children. So, rather than destroy them at that time - instead He chose rather to destroy the earth age, which was beautiful at that time. No winter nor summer - just plush all around the earth. People had it real good then. I would reference the documentary that we did concerning the angelic footprint. Yes, they were here. That documents it - and they*

didn't look like a monkey. Because it's a perfect footprint. (He shows it) this footprint is set in stone and it's about 10 million years old. Some professors say longer. There are many things that have passed on before us - and God's Word declares them. I guess the question is - are you wise enough to listen to the simplicity in which God teaches them? Like He said - 'Hey, I didn't hide in some dark place to say this. I made it very plain in the Word - My Word - God's Word - that the things were of old - and I shook it. I destroyed it. Every last being off the face of the earth.' Heaven wasn't destroyed - the earth was. But He destroyed it - rather than destroying His children. Think about it - we serve a God of love. What would it take to have a parent destroy one of his children? Think about it - it's a heavy way to go. That's why He didn't kill them - rather He chose to destroy the earth age, and cause each man to become flesh also. Every one would have to pass through this earth age to make his or her mind up - born innocent of woman - whether they would love God or Satan. That's what it's all about - and that's why you're here. You see, contrary to what many people teach - there is one thing God will not do - it's just not in Him - He's not going to do it - He's not going to force you to love Him. Because whether it is you or God - you can't force anyone to love you. It's fake. He wants you to love Him from within yourself. You - with freewill - having that option of loving Him or the ways of the world, which is to say Satan. The choice is yours! But, I assure you, you have been warned by our Father what happens to those that follow the ways of the world. By that I mean, love Satan instead of Him - because God will not put up with false love. He knows your heart and mind - He knows whether you love Him or not. Love is very important to Him. Do you know something? It's important to all of us. We like to be loved. We like to be needed, wanted - and we like to be appreciated. And when we look upon someone who has been as good to us as our Father has been, you can't help loving Him. If you come into knowledge and the wisdom of what He has done for us. Even coming to this earth Himself to die on the cross - in the form of the Son - the only begotten. To show you that He didn't feel He was too good to do what He has asked you to do. That is to say... live in the flesh. So, we have a wonderful Father - rather than destroying His children- He destroyed the first earth age and brought this one into being. We'll pick up in the next lecture...the creation. You will note that almost every verse in the first chapter of Genesis begins with 'and', which is a polysyndeton. In other words, there's a lot more said than is written. Each time this 'and' is used - as the creator and the Spirit to cover over the world to put it into the condition that we have it today - from that chaotic situation. As God stipulated in that great Book of Isaiah - I didn't hide this from you (as we read in chapter 45 v. 19) I didn't create it void and without form - it became that way. I didn't hide it from you - didn't speak it from some dark place - it's there for everybody to recognize and enjoy, whereby there is not a conflict with nature itself. We are able at this time to document how old this earth is. And a Bible scholar can do the same with the Word of God. In understanding it.

Genesis 1:3 “And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.”

Genesis 1:4 “And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.” *Now here in a sense - think of the children of light and the children of darkness. Think of the Prince of Light and the prince of darkness. Then understanding will begin to come to you concerning this.*

Genesis 1:5 “And God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.” *Now, stop and think for a moment. This is the end of the first day. We don't have any stars yet - and the sun and the moon hasn't been created yet. And yet there was light. Let's look at the Book of Revelation to help you understand as we go to the third age - the one that's coming. Revelation 21:23 (We're already in the Millennium. We are in our new bodies - our eternal bodies and this is what the Word says concerning the city.) “And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.” You can put this together for yourself - God was there. Light always gives life. God is the life-giver. So, it was the Spirit of God that lightened the world and dispatched the darkness at that time. It was not the light that we know of today as the sun and the moon. Now, sometimes you have to close your flesh eyes to open your spiritual eyes - to understand and grasp what our Father wants you to know. Know that compared to His brightness, His glory - that He is in fact, the only light we need. All other light is provided by Him for us and for the creatures of the world. So the light that is spoken of here is not what some would think - but is the very presence of God. This also comes to the point that it can separate the children of light (day) from the children of darkness (night). You can practically teach Revelation from this Book of Genesis. Also much of the New Testament. As much as the children of the day are in the light and the children of the night... being with Satan in the darkness. If you are in God - He is with you...so you never walk in darkness. You are a child of light. It is for this reason that all prophecies given concerning God's children are given in days. Solar. The solar calendar. And all prophecies given concerning Satan are given in months, which is to say moons, or darkness. The moon (lunar) calendar is chaotic. It's a mess to keep up with the moons. The solar calendar is perfect because it never changes. The spring equinox happens the same year in, year out. It's for that reason that Shepherd's Chapel goes by the solar calendar in determining Passover. OK - you get the message - God was with us, He was there - He was the light - and it was good.*

Genesis 1:6 “And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.” *Let there be an expansion. Bear in*

mind that back in Isaiah 45:18, God created the earth out of the water - not in the water. But, in that overthrow of Satan's rebellion, there was a flood that would make Noah's flood look like a spring shower. I know some will resent this - but be that as it may. Yet, all the destruction - and you can still see signs of it in this world even at this time. We now have the North Pole 90 miles from true north. It happened instantly. All pilots have to correct their compass by 5-7 degrees to compensate for this. We have found many proofs of this in remains, and we know that it happened. But here, He's dividing the water back again, and He's not talking about the receding waters of Noah's flood.

Genesis 1:7 *"And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the water which were above the firmament; and it was so." In other words, He caused the waters to recede. He put some of the water back into the firmament (atmosphere) and so it was. If you use your mind just a moment, you might know where much of that water came from that brought that flood to pass. If there was actually water overhead that filtered.*

Genesis 1:8 *"And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day." In a sense, He created earth and heaven on that second day for this earth age. Let me rephrase this because it could mislead someone. He brought both the earth and the heaven into the day of this earth age. They were both already here - heaven is wherever God is. He didn't build another earth or create another earth, He simply caused the waters to recede and move upward into the atmosphere whereby land could become a habitation.*

Genesis 1:9 *"And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so." God spoke and it happened.*

Genesis 1:10 *"And called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called the Seas: and God saw that it was good." Not chaotic - or disturbed any more into a nothingness. It was coming back to its' beauty. Wonder when the plates moved? You know we found those African animals in Nebraska at Ashfall. It's absolute - no getting around it. Camels and birds of Africa that died about 10 million years ago. Interesting...how God moved this and how He moved that!*

Genesis 1:11 *"And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself upon the earth: and it was so." In other words, the seed to replenish itself was in itself...after it's kind. And that's the way God liked it.*

Genesis 1:12 “And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good.” *God likes things to stay as He created them. Men always want to manipulate.*

Genesis 1:13 “And the evening and the morning were the third day.” *Now, make note, chronologically, of these events. Keep them in order in your mind. On the first day...God’s presence...light. Second day...creating the land itself...separated from the water. Third day... new grass, seeds, trees and so forth.*

Genesis 1:14 “And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven (atmosphere) to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.” *In other words, we were supposed to utilize the sun and the moon as signs for seasons...with everything on it’s compass...set with it’s rotation. Many people think it’s foolish to talk about signs and seasons - but no it isn’t. If you want to be a successful farmer, it pays you to pay attention. Example: if the moon, which is the reason we have tides from the seas, oceans - If the moon can raise the water level five feet or more at high tide simply by a certain phase of the moon - think about it. Do you realize how many metric tons are involved in that? It would be very difficult for man to understand the force that it would take to raise the water level to that elevation by the pull of the moon. Do you think that if it could raise the water level in the ocean - what it does to our subterranean (surface) water. Water below the surface. Naturally, it pulls that water closer to the surface. It helps our crops grow. So, yeah, there’s something to it. When you have power like that in play, by God’s natural way - naturally it pays to pay attention.*

Genesis 1:15 “And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth; and it was so.”

Genesis 1:16 “And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also.” *Here we have that perfect zodiac, which really is God’s Bible in the stars. You with Companion Bibles - you have an appendix on this subject. Interesting. God’s overall plan is perfect.*

Genesis 1:17 “And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth,” *And again, this was natural light from God in His own way. As well as the light of God’s own presence.*

Genesis 1:18 “And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that it was good.”

Genesis 1:19 “And the evening and the morning were the fourth day.” So here we come to this fourth day and we see that we have the stars, the sun, the moon, the zodiac, etc. One is not to make a religion out of that study...but it is good to know how it applies to God’s Word. So, we have grass, we have herbs, vegetation is put into place in the earth. We have the sun, the moon and the stars, so let’s continue. Be sure to keep these chronologically in order.

Genesis 1:20 “And God said, Let the waters (waters - not the earth) bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life (nephesh - which means soul), and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.” Now I give you, for supposition only...I repeat - this is supposition only - something simply for you to think about. I’m not teaching it - it’s for your own thought process. Nephesh (soul) is translated 472 times as the soul of human beings. 282 times it definitely is animal and 44 for different species. It is ironic - knowing God’s time - not being ignorant of it - that 1,000 years is 1 day with God - that when we look at a living thing with a soul created from the waters of the sea, which contains the same minerals that clay does. The people that grow their wheat from the sea (or in water) - as a matter of fact, Oriental history goes back much, much longer than the history even of the Hebrew. This is well recorded, well documented - and again, it’s strictly supposition. I’m not teaching it, but I feel that it is something that as you look around at history (that’s His-story) that you stop and think. I would not wish to debate the case, but at least be aware.

Genesis 1:21 “And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.” So here, we have God creating the fish and the fowls. We have water birds and dry land birds - whales, fish with scales, fish that are scavengers and so forth.

Genesis 1:22 “And God blessed them (did you hear that? God blessed them), saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth.” In other words, to bring back that we found that was taken away in the 4th chapter of Jeremiah at the overthrow of Satan. New creations for this earth age.

Genesis 1:23 “And the evening and the morning were the fifth day.” Now, here we come up to this day and we’ve got grass and we’ve got fish and we’ve got birds and wildlife. We still don’t have a man. This is important that you know. Animals were created before man. That is to say the animals of the wilderness.

Genesis 1:24 “And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.”

Genesis 1:25 “And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good.” *And here we have the earthbound animals aside from fish and fowl. We have cattle, sheep, the bovine (cows), camels, etc.*

Genesis 1:26 “And God said, Let us make man in our image *(now, think about this. This is God speaking. Where’s this ‘our’ come from? Who was there? His sons, of course. As it is written...God and His children... the Elohim. Every soul that God created was with Him), after our likeness: (let’s make him to look exactly like we are. That’s why when you see Jesus Christ born from above, not born again, which is an incorrect translation in the 3rd chapter of John. That’s why God could say through the mouth of Jesus Christ - if you have seen the son, then you have seen the Father. Why? They are made to look exactly alike. As you are made to look exactly like you did there) and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea (fishermen), and over the fowl of the air (hunters), and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.”*

Genesis 1:27 “So God created man in his own image *(notice that the word ‘own’ is in italics, meaning it was added) in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.” It’s important for you to note that in this record of the 6-day creation, that the male and female were created simultaneously...at the same time. And the fact that they were created rather than formed is important. So, there you have it. We have the creation on the sixth day of both male and female*

Genesis 1:28 “And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.” *Why this word ‘replenish’? If I give you a brand new basket, it’s never had anything in it...and tell you to replenish it with corn. You would say, Pastor, it’s never had any corn in it. How would I replenish it? And you would be correct. Now, if it were a basket that had had corn in it before - then I would be correct in saying to replenish the supply of corn in the basket. So it is with the earth. We read in Jeremiah 4, in the rebellion - that God removed - took from the earth every last man. They were gone. And remember His threat - I did it once before, so if you don’t think I’ll do it again - just stand by. So, He created the races on the sixth day and instructed*

them to replenish the earth. Resupply it again. The difference being that man would be in a flesh body this time instead of an angelic body.

Genesis 1:29 “And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree (*underline this in your mind - every tree*), in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.” *This is oranges, apples, plums although they are not specified. You haven’t seen the word ‘apple’ in the Bible). The word ‘ates’ meaning the fruit tree. You can partake of these. No problem.*

Genesis 1:30 “And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.” *In other words, God gives them hunting, fishing, fruit gatherers, wild berries - this sort of thing.*

Genesis 1:31 “And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.” *It is my contention - and I do teach it - that when God created the races on that sixth day - that He created both man and woman at the same time. And populated the earth with the various races. You know, it’s not been that many generations back to that 6,000 year period when this took place. I’m talking about the 6th day. And people, following the natural flow of things - stay as they are. We make small environmental changes - that is to say evolution in a sense. I’m not saying evolution... meaning a change - but that these marvelous bodies that God created will adapt to temperatures - by the thinning or the thickening of the blood - so on and so forth. The ingenuity that man has in survival. But God created the races, both male and female at the same time. He looked on everything... and it wasn’t that it was just good - but very good. This is why nobody should ever apologize for their race in front of this man. Because God created every race the way He wanted it. And it was not just good - it was very good!*

I don’t want you to miss the next lecture - because we’re going to get into an 8th-day man. That’s why it’s important that you chronologically keep in mind that He brought the stars and moon, then the grass, trees, fish, etc. And then on the 6th day, He brought man and woman on the scene simultaneously - to replenish the earth. We’re going to find out in the next lecture - He realizes that He has hunters and fishermen - but He doesn’t have a husbandman, which means a farmer. So He creates another man - ‘ha-adam’ in the Hebrew tongue. It can only be picked up from the Hebrew manuscript. I know of no one else that teaches as I do - from these manuscripts in this manner. That does not bother me. I have studied it long and I have studied it well. And there is

no reason for racial tension when one comes to the understanding that God loves all His children. He looks and it is very good.

*And God created kind after kind - they're special to Him. So, to do what He created each of us to do, you know we get this nonsense. Let's say that the Africans came from Noah's son, Ham because he uncovered his father's nakedness. There's nothing natural about this unless you understand what uncovering your father's nakedness means. In Leviticus 18:8, and 20:11, you will find that that is to have intercourse with his father's wife. 18:8 **'The nakedness of thy father's wife shalt thou not uncover: it is thy father's nakedness.'** That's why they had to get Noah drunk first, and when Noah passed out - Ham seduced Noah's wife - his own mother. That's why the curse fell on the offspring of that incestuous affair...Canaan. But, they were both Adamic offspring from this ha-adam, as we will find. They were naturally ruddy complected, so there is no way that African-Americans could have come from this incestuous affair. It's an insult to say that they did. And a curse was placed upon them. No - it was Canaan. God never deals in something un-natural, such as changing a man's color. That that is - is the way He created it. So, all races were created on the sixth day with the exception of ha-adam, which we'll discuss in the next lecture. It's not complicated.*

CHAPTER 2

In the first chapter, we found out that there was an earth age before this one, which explains why many things will carbon-date into the millions of years. It's explained right in God's Word if we will just take the time to cover it.

We have passed the sixth day - and in going into chapter 2 - we will be in the seventh day. God has already created male and female in the image of God and the Elohim, which is to say God and His children. He said to make them look just like we look. And naturally, everyone had to pass through this earth age one time - and one time only.

Genesis 2:1 ***"Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them."** Now, I want you to think on this for a moment. Meditate on it - and let it sink in. The heaven was finished and the earth was finished. And the host of them. What does the word 'host' mean? From the manuscripts #6635 (tsaba) - a mass of persons - especially organized for war. It's a family - the family of God. We can pass with this. What does it mean? Stop and think. The heavens were finished, the earth was finished and the people were finished. That is to say, the souls were ready for this earth age. God had created animals and fish, birds - then He created man - and He looked at every race and it was very good.*

Genesis 2:2 “And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had made; and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had made.” Now, I leave it with you. What is one day with God? Peter said in II Peter, that I would not have you ignorant of the fact that one day with God is 1,000 years with man. So, if it were one of God’s days, actually He would have rested for a millennium.

Genesis 2:3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it (set it aside): because that in it He had rested from all His work which God created and made.” He was pleased with it. Now for the sake of the higher critic, I want to say that I know we’re going from P to J here. You don’t have to remind me - I’m well aware of it. I’m very familiar with the manuscripts.

Genesis 2:4 “These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,” This word ‘generation’ would be better translated ‘history’, because we’re talking about heaven and earth and not entities. So, this is the history of the earth...meaning back to Genesis 1:1-2, that in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...PERIOD. It became void and without form, so this is the history of not only this earth age - but the one that came before. Don’t overlook this.

Genesis 2:5 “And every plant of the field before it was in the earth (seed), and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground.” This means ‘to farm the ground’. Now, here’s where we want to be very careful. God created men and women on the same day... the sixth day...male & female at the same time. He let them have liberties to harvest the wild game, the crops and so forth that were wild. But never did He give one of those - one of the races - the duties of farming...tilling the ground. To be a husbandman of the soil. I want to make this really clear, so stay with me on this.

Genesis 2:6 “But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.” This would be considered dew - but keep in mind that before the flood of Noah, we will still have a firmament overhead.

Genesis 2:7 Please give me your full attention because we’re going to have a lesson in Hebrew grammar here. “And the LORD God formed (not created - but formed) man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.” Now, there’s something quite different about this man...from the man mentioned in the 27th verse of the first chapter. It would probably

serve you well if you wrote these down. You with Companion Bibles don't have to - because you have appendix 14 will already have it recorded there for you. Adam (without the article) as it utilized in verse 27 of chapter 1, means 'man or mankind'. There's not even any gender involved in it. As a matter of fact, many times from the manuscripts, adam is translated 'man', when the word in the Hebrew is 'adam'...without the article.

Now, here in this particular verse (7) - this man has the article 'ha-adam'. And with the article, it denotes 'the man - adam - to till the soil'. You should make a note of this. I'll repeat it one more time - adam without the article 'ha....in English -the', denotes human or mankind. It doesn't mean adam, which Christ would say He wasn't the son of Adam, or be called the Son of Adam. But, it would be this adam 'ha-adam' through which Christ would come - not the man without the article in verse 27 of chapter 1. I really know of no one else who teaches this publicly, (it is taught - but not publicly). I make no apologies for teaching it although I have had a particular Rabbi that said I was correct - BUT - you're going to be criticized for throwing racial overtones into this. Hey, I teach God's Word as it is - I make no apology for teaching it as it is written. Because this is the way God wanted it taught. And fallout from it doesn't bother me...at least I know that I've taught the truth.

Now there is more. I will even go further to say that even the Companion Bible in chapter 1 & 2 will disagree in part with what I'm saying. That's ok. But, it's still the best study Bible you will ever be able to touch with your hands. I want to take this one step further. Again, I hope you've written down - adam without the article denotes man or mankind in general. Adam with the article (ha) denotes 'the man-adam'. But, we have something more specific than that. We have adam not only with the article, but with the particle - eth... and when we have the addition of eth - it's very emphatic. I can't express this enough. With the article, particle and adam - I can say super-emphatic. We're talking about this man! The one that is set aside here with the article and particle. Let's simplify it in case I'm confusing someone with articles and particles. The article is ha (which is 'the') and the particle is eth (which is always 'emphatic' no matter what it's talking about). This is grammar from the Hebrew tongue.

Many of you have trouble separating the man from chapter 1:27 and the man from 2:7. For you that have not caught all of it - I'm going one more time...in verse 7, we have eth-ha-adam, which is emphatically 'the tiller of the ground'. From which Christ would be called 'the Son of Adam'. Christ would be called the second Adam. This comes to mind from I Corinthians, chapter 15. One more time through it - adam - first of all what does this word mean? Adam means 'ruddy complected'. All the other races were created on the sixth day. There was a ruddy complected man formed on that day as

well. Back to the article and the particle. Adam without the article or particle - denotes man or mankind...a human being. But, as it is used in verse 7, adam with the article denotes 'the man - adam'.

God even goes further than that, so that you get the distinction. In verse 7 - He places the particle - eth before the article - eth-ha-adam, which makes it very emphatic. So that you would not go wrong. Never let it be said that this has not been taught to you. What makes the difference in the man to till the soil and the man that would hunt and fish - He chose this specific man because through this genealogy of ha-adam would come Christ. That's important because that would bring forth the Savior and round out God's overall plan. Let's continue on...

Genesis 2:8 *"And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there He put the man whom He had formed." Not created - but formed!*

Genesis 2:9 *"And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil." I'm going to save a good education for you on trees from the Hebrew tongue until the next lecture. But let me just say this in passing - the good trees for food are still with us today. There's nothing new under the sun. These are nut and fruit trees. But the tree of life is a different subject. The tree of the knowledge of good and evil is a different type. Let's put it that way. The tree of life - the tree that gives life is Jesus Christ. The tree of the knowledge of good (yes, Satan knows how to be good...he was created good) but he is evil. That tree happens to be Satan. We'll document all this in the next lecture - from the Word of God. The point being that God wants you to recognize this man.*

Understand that when God makes a statement like this - then it becomes law.

Genesis 2:10 *"And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads."*

Genesis 2:11 *"The name of the first is Pison: that is it which compasseth (circles) the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold;"*

Genesis 2:12 *"And the gold of that land is good: there is bdellium and the onyx stone."*

Genesis 2:13 *"And the name of the second river is Gihon: the same is that compasseth the whole land of Ethiopia." Now, if we were to go by the geographical*

location that we know of Ethiopia today, we can fix some of these rivers that could have been part of the area.

Genesis 2:14 *“And the name of the third river is Hiddekel: that is it which goeth toward the east of Assyria. And the fourth river is Euphrates.” This is why many people feel that where the Euphrates and Tigris run together - that it was the geographical location of the Garden of Eden. It could certainly indicate this.*

Genesis 2:15 *“And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.” I want you to note that - many of you who have the Green’s Interlinear will have one of the best sets of the Hebrew manuscripts that are available today. I’ll even go further - the best! This brings it through - ‘the man, ha-adam’. Check it out. It has the article - that’s the one He put in the garden.*

Genesis 2:16 *“And the LORD God commanded the man (that is to say... ha-adam), saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:” Feed yourself - we still do to this day.*

Genesis 2:17 *“But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.” Did Adam die in the day that he ate of the tree? No, he didn’t. Did Eve die on the day that she ate of the tree? No, she didn’t. Not instantly. But, don’t forget how long a day is with God. That’s why no one ever lived over 1,000 years - that’s one day! After the fall, no one ever passed that mark.*

Genesis 2:18 *“And the LORD God said, it is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.” Whoa, wait a minute. Here we’ve got Adam in the garden - and God created male and female back on the 6th day - so this lets you know that we are talking about two different peoples here. He’s not talking about classes here, so don’t ever tag ‘racist’ onto this. It rather protects the races whereby they can understand our loving Father - that He created us as we are ... and He looked and it was very good. But, we have one man here that doesn’t have a female. God created male and female back on verse 1:27 simultaneously...they were both created at the same time. Let’s read it again - 1:27 “So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.” But here we have eth-ha-adam without a wife. Let’s see what God does for him...*

Genesis 2:19 *“And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the*

name thereof.” *Whoa, does this not square with you? I mean, we know from chapter 1 - that God created the birds, the fowl, the fish before He ever created man. And now it says that He created ha-adam - and now He's created some more animals and brought them to ha-adam to name them. So, we have something that doesn't square - except for one thing....supposition - my opinion only - these are animals that ha-adam would utilize to till the soil. That is to say - domestic animals. The horses, donkeys, chickens, cows - the farm animals...AFTER he formed ha-adam. I think it's important that you note these things because it's clearly written in the Word of God. It helps you make the division whereby we see that God does not play favoriteism with His people. He is simply setting aside one through which would come the Savior, in which all races could have eternal life by following Him. There was no curse put on any people - it's a sin for anyone to teach that any actions of these adamic people brought about certain races. God doesn't deal in un-natural acts, or curse innocent people. And don't ever believe some preacher that would tell you that. He created every race as it was on the sixth day and it was very good. So, here we go. He gave him the animals before He gave him the woman - why was that? I have no idea.*

Genesis 2:20 *“And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field (living beings of the world); but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.” Still all by himself.*

Genesis 2:21 *“And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;” He had surgery.*

Genesis 2:22 *“And the rib (make a note - the rib), which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.” Now, I'll let you check it out for yourself in the Hebrew. But the prime in this word 'rib' simply means 'the curve'. Man translated it 'rib' - but it's actually 'curve'. The rib does curve - given! But, man has something else that is more in the line of genetics that decides male and female - which we have learned through medical technology in the past several years - and it's called DNA. Do you know that DNA has a curve? Ever heard of the helix curve? Sometimes you just change a few chromosomes - and presto - we have male and female. Basically, they're both the same. But, certainly, through the curve, it is very possible that this is the correction that God made whereby He created a help mate for this ha-adam as the female on the sixth day - bringing forth a womb in this soul that would enable each of the hosts to be born of woman - innocent - not remembering anything from before...to decide whether they would love God or Satan. You make your own bed - make your own life and it's exactly what you made it. We'll find out before we get to chapter 6 - that God was grieved that He had made man flesh - but the stage was*

set and it was done. I like to understand how and why God does things. Therefore, we can better grasp what God would have us do. Knowledge and wisdom is a beautiful thing. I truly believe that this is what God took from Adam and formed the beautiful woman body ...and thank God for it. Women are a lot prettier than we men are. It's the greatest gift God ever gave man.

Genesis 2:23 *"And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." Who took her out of man? And do we have an article here with this? Yes!*

Genesis 2:24 *"Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh." This is very important. Marriage is a union and God is giving us here some of the best marital advice you could ever have in your life. You leave Mama and Daddy and become one unit with your spouse. With wisdom - figure things out to your satisfaction, because inasmuch as you are one flesh - and the right side of the flesh should never offend anything on the left side. It's got to get along.*

Genesis 2:25 *"And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed." They had done nothing to be ashamed of. Only sin brings forth shame. And unfortunately in the next chapter, we get into where sin does enter. We will be talking about trees. I'm going to give you quite an education about trees...symbolism and what actually happened in the garden.*

We've completed chapter 2 and up to this point - you haven't heard the words 'apple' or 'orange' yet. And I've got some news for you - you're not going to hear the word 'apple' in the next lecture either. Scripturally speaking. This isn't the kind of tree that God wants you to be aware of.

So, in recapping - anytime 'adam' is utilized in the Hebrew language - with the article - it is 'the man - adam'. If it is without the article - it is human or mankind. With both the particle and article - eth-ha-adam, it's emphatically the adam that God formed to till the soil, and to bring forth - through the woman - Mother Eve - who will be called 'the mother of all living' for one reason only. Because through Eve's womb, umbilical cord to umbilical cord - would come Christ. Messiah! And you're either in Him or you're not living! Eve is the mother of all eternal living because the Savior would come through her. That's why Satan always hassled Eve and gives her much trouble when the opportunity prevails.

CHAPTER 3

I want to say a word before I begin today. Many people just love labels...such as the way so and so teaches. If someone teaches this way - he must be so and so. This denomination or that. Hey, it doesn't matter what this person or that person - how much of it or how little - what matters is what does the Word of God say! And anyone that will bend from teaching God's Word exactly as it is written - don't try to label them. I don't care if it is different than you might have been taught - then maybe you had better dig deeper. What is important is to document it - know that it is God's Word - and I don't care what man says about it - stick with God's Word and you'll always be a winner. I kinda dislike labels - I like to be a child of God that studies His Word - PERIOD! Because there's not anything really important in this world shaping your morals, or your success as God's Word will. So, always stick with it and don't care a lot about what men say.

I hope I'm preparing you for a chapter that goes to some depths and many people shy away from controversy. But anyone that would call God's Word a controversy - or would shy away from it - is just a little bit too 'out there' for God. He's not going to visit them - always teach it the way it is written.

Remember the creation of the sixth day man? Remember the creation after the rest of the seventh day? That we had eth-ha-adam - the 8th day man created. That specific one and then certain domestic animals and then his wife. That's where we left it - now let's pick it up with Chapter 3...

Genesis 3:1 *"Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. (He was smarter - always slinking around trying to take advantage) And he said unto the woman, (maybe he found a weak spot...well, would he be surprised?) Yea, hath God said (what's Satan's method of operation? He's always quoting God...that's how he tempted Jesus), Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?"* Now, this is wide open. Don't forget that God gave orders (which became law) ... they could eat of every tree EXCEPT the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. We're going to be talking about trees at length today because God uses symbology oftentimes to teach on a deeper vein than many people are able to receive. So hang tough. This is not what God said - it's what Satan asked her.

Genesis 3:2 *"And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:"*

Genesis 3:3 “But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall you touch it, lest ye die.” *It becomes very important that you know what this word ‘touch’ is because it’s kinda like I’ve told you before - if you don’t start the truth like for example if you were opening a feed sack or a flour sack - if you don’t get the thread started right - you’ll have it all hacked up. You need to know exactly what God said - what He has spoken concerning the serpent...this tree.*

So let’s have the word ‘touch’ in the Hebrew tongue...Strong’s #5060 naga’ - a primitive root; properly, to touch, ie: to lay the hand upon (for any purpose; euphem, to lie with a woman); by implication, to reach and so forth. That will do it. What then is a euphemism? It’s where someone uses the word ‘touch’ to be a nicer word - the interpreters thought ‘touch’ would be a better word than ‘intercourse’. But, that’s what it means. Now, many might say, ‘O dear Lord - did you hear what he just said?’ I didn’t say it - God said it! That’s what the word means in the Hebrew tongue. And if you’re too good for God’s Word - then you really are a goody-goody two shoes, aren’t you? You need to stick with God’s Word so that you understand God’s Word.

Now, what God had said - the implication is sufficient to clear itself up. Don’t get away from me now. It’s a little heavy for some - but put it on the shelf - but it is God’s Word and I give you and tell you how to acquire the tools. If I say that naga’ means a certain thing in Hebrew, you can easily check it out yourself in a Strong’s Concordance, or a good Hebrew dictionary. It’s not that big a push for an English reader.

Genesis 3:4 “And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die.” *Well, now - here he lies...Ye shall not surely die. But God has already told them that they will. So, who are you going to believe? Basically, this is what life comes down to. You make your own bed. It wasn’t God that brought death into the world - many say it was Eve - but no, it was Satan. But, Eve (as well as Adam), by not being obedient to God - did bring death into the world through Satan.*

How can we understand then - ‘touch’? Can we verify that just a little bit more? What it’s talking about? We certainly can! Let’s go to II Corinthians 11:2, and understand this word ‘touch’ just a little bit more. Paul teaching...

II Corinthians 11:2 “For I am jealous over you with Godly jealousy: for I have espoused (engaged) you to one husband (Christ, of course), that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.” *This is to say that you won’t be deceived...you won’t be beguiled - and the subject here is the loss of virginity. In a spiritual sense here, you bet, but listen to it carefully.*

II Corinthians 11:3 “But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.” Now, it’s very important that you know this word ‘beguiled’. It is ‘exapatao’ in the Greek. It comes from #1537 and #1538 - it has one meaning only...‘to seduce wholly’! Completely. It doesn’t have any other meaning. Let it be settled in your mind - verified even in the New Testament as to what we’re talking about in the garden. From the Hebrew word ‘naga’ as well as the beguiling of Eve. If we were to continue on in this 11th chapter - we would find for it to be no marvel - because in the end times - Satan himself will come in the English tongue - transformed in verse 14. But it is ‘disguised’. Satan’s is subtle - he’s always disguising himself. This is using an actual event so that that which is spiritual for you - can be brought to pass in your life so you are not deceived. Let the Word flow - this is what you need to know.

Genesis 3:5 “For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof (Satan continues speaking), then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.” In other words, you will find enlightenment. Now, let’s hold on just a minute. Number 1 - never trust Satan. What does it mean - you’ll be like us - angelic beings - you will know good from evil. At this time, Eve was created innocent. But, I don’t want you to forget the comment - ‘your eyes shall be opened’. I’ll document for you that certainly ... rather than an opening - what was about to transpire would bring about a ‘closing’.

Here’s the word that is utilized in the Hebrew tongue (ates); from #6095: a tree. (from its firmness hence wood or sticks). For instance, what do you call your arms? Limbs. And what about the torso of the body? What is it called? The trunk, of course. So, there’s nothing new under the sun. It’s not unusual at all for a person to use God’s thought Let’s go to #6095 - the prime from which #6086 comes from. ‘Atsah’: a primitive root; properly to fasten or to make firm. This is what I want you to get from it...i.e. to close (the eyes). What did Satan say? Surely your eyes will be opened. Let’s go on to #6096.

Strong’s #6096. Notice that it is also from #6095 so that you get the full picture here. The spine (aw-tseh’)....(as giving firmness to the body): So, we’re talking about the backbone of the body. Here we can begin to understand why Satan would lie - when the prime from the word is to close the eyes. But, Satan says ‘surely they will be opened’. What it means is that it will close your spiritual eyes and open eyes to the world.

I want to show you the word 'tree' as it is used of eating all of the fruit of the garden...the Hebrew word #6086. You need to know how God uses the word 'tree'. It's very important. God uses symbology whereas with symbology He is able to say more than what is written, and also to protect tender ears. It's not unusual for us to address 'tree' as our own bodies. God even called Satan a tree in Ezekiel 32 when he was talking to Pharaoh, rather than call Satan a Cedar of Lebanon (which is symbolic of our people) - He called him a plain old Box Cedar. He wanted to be something really special - but all he is is an old box cedar. So, it's not unusual for God to refer to men as trees.

Know and understand that it's not an unusual term for us to say that this is the trunk of my body or what about your family? Many of you are proud of them. Some of us have one or two that we would like to break off a couple of limbs - it's called the family tree. It's not unusual at all.

Genesis 3:6 *"And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes (now picture what's happening), and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her' and he did eat."* Understand that they both partook of the same fruit. She simply directed her husband to it. Again, is it unusual for God to mention men as trees? No. I really want to nail this one down.

Let's go to Isaiah 61:3 God speaking..."To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion (because the antichrist has taken over), to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified." Now, God planted trees, but it seems that Satan had a habit of planting trees also. Christ Himself was even called 'the branch'.

Now, I have a question for you. Some might say, 'this is just a little bit steep'...if you're talking about what I think you're talking about - conception, and people not retaining their virginity for the coming of Christ - this is really kind of heavy. But it's what God's Word states. Let me ask you a question. Have you observed as yet the word 'apple'? I guarantee you that as a student of the Hebrew, 'apple' is not mentioned in the manuscripts, either. There's no way that you can translate any tree that's been mentioned here as 'apple'. I wonder how many of you can remember - 'oh yes, dear children, Eve ate an apple off an apple tree'. Lie! It's not there. Preachers are lying to the children of God. Now, which is better in God's eyes? That you teach the truth or that you lie to His children? It gives a warped view of what happened in the garden - that little children have to maintain for the rest of their lives. Trust me, I have grown adult people that will write to me after this teaching and say, 'I know the word 'apple' is

in there - just where is it?'. They just cannot shake off that that was taught to them. You know, a little child will trust the adults and elders of the church. And, it's very difficult to remove lies and false teaching from their mind after they are implanted there by people they trust. We're just winning friends and influencing people here. I'm not saying this to insult anyone - but to shame you if that's what you're teaching. It's contrary to the Word of God. I assure you that the serpent loves it! The pictures of the apple and the tree and so forth. When the whole thing is a lie.

Genesis 3:7 *"And the eyes of them both were opened (opened to the ways of the world....sin), and they knew that they were naked (the backbone with the central nervous system running through it has already passed the message up to the brain where the knowledge of good and evil is. That's why the tree of the knowledge of good evil is Satan himself); and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons."* Now, I can't help saying it. The meaning in the Hebrew for aprons is to girt themselves. They didn't eat an apple so they made a little mask for themselves. Put the little fig leaf right over their mouth. NO - they made aprons to cover their private parts because of what they had just done. Let's not lie to children concerning God's Word. It makes Him very angry.

Jesus told you in Matthew 24 and Mark 13 - not that maybe you should learn the parable of the fig tree. – BUT TO LEARN IT! And this is the very rock foundation of the fig tree. If you don't understand this - you're not going to understand any of His other parables. As it's written in Mark 4 - concerning this very thing. It's the reason God speaks through Christ in parables to those that have eyes to see and ears to hear. They made aprons. They covered their nakedness.

Genesis 3:8 *"And they hear the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden." Why? They sinned - they disobeyed.*

Genesis 3:9 *"And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?"*

Genesis 3:10 *"And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself."*

Genesis 3:11 *"And He said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?" Yes,*

he had because of the evilness that he had shared with him and the woman both. It made them ashamed.

Genesis 3:12 *“And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.” It’s all her fault. There’s Adam, bless his heart...trying to pass it off and blame it on the woman. When he was the one who should have kept it from happening in the first place.*

Genesis 3:13 *“And the LORD God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.” I don’t have to tell you what happened there. You can tell by the outcome of it. Listen to God, those of you who might have difficulty understanding it.*

Genesis 3:14 *“And the LORD God said unto the serpent (you know who the serpent is - it’s that old devil, the dragon, Satan) Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:” In other words, this is a statement of degradation - that Satan could never again rise to a point of salvation or anything else.*

Genesis 3:15 *(How sharp are you? Can you listen to the Word of God without thinking of labels or what you’ve heard in the past? Can you just let God speak?) “And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed (seed - we’re talking about children here); it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” This is the first prophecy. Satan knew that it would be from this woman that Christ would come. And God is saying that because you tried to destroy that, I will put enmity between thy seed and the woman’s seed. Meaning Christ was nailed by His heel - but Christ ultimately will crush the head of the serpent. And so it is. How can we be sure that Jesus would teach something like that? How about reading it? You’ll find out that Jesus did teach that Satan did have seed - children here on earth. But you have some Biblically illiterate ... so-called teachers that would tell you otherwise.*

Christ teaching here. This has to do with the parable of the tares and the sower. And this is the parable Christ said if you don’t understand this one - you can’t understand the rest of the parables. And it’s true. The disciples were asking him - what is this parable of the sower?

Matthew 13:37 “He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;” *That is to say the Spirit of God was with God when the Spirit moved and God created the different races on the earth. The good!*

Matthew 13:38 “The field is the world (*He is explaining the parable*); the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children (*from the conception*) of the wicked one;”

Matthew 13:39 “The enemy that sowed them (*here we’re gonna find out what really happened*) is the devil (*the tree of the knowledge of good and evil - the serpent - that old dragon. You can find all of his names listed in Revelation chapter 20.*); the harvest is the end of the world; and the readers are the angels.” *Yes, it shall come to pass. Yes, Christ taught about the children of the serpent. He did - and I make no apologies for it, or should you ever have any desire to want to. I think this pretty well clears it up - does it not? Getting back to Genesis...*

Genesis 3:16 “Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception (*what had happened? conception!*); in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.”

Genesis 3:17 “And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast harkened unto the voice of thy wife (*rather than listening to God*), and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee (*here’s where he sinned - it wasn’t listening to his wife - it was NOT listening to God*), saying, Thou shalt not eat of it (*period!*): cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life.” *And man has had to grub out a living ever since.*

Genesis 3:18 “Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee, and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;” *Exactly as it is written - it has always been. There’s nothing new under the sun. If you don’t understand what happened in the beginning - you’re not going to understand the end.*

Genesis 3:19 “In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken; for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.” *And so it is. Many people talk about these bodies raising up - but no, you don’t. These bodies return to dust. You’re raised in a spiritual body.*

Genesis 3:20 “ And Adam called his wife’s name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.” *Only because it would be Christ that would come through her*

womb (umbilical cord to umbilical cord) and if you don't have Christ - then you're not living. That's what this has reference to. All God's children - all races!

Genesis 3:21 "Unto Adam also and to his wife did the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them." *There was blood shed because of this sin...and the skins taken to make clothing.*

Genesis 3:22 "And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take (*this word is not naga nor is it touch*) also of the tree of life (*Jesus Christ Himself*), and eat, and live for ever:"

Genesis 3:23 "Therefore the LORD God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken."

Genesis 3:24 "So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way (*all directions*), to keep the way of the tree of life." *Do you know what way that is? Christ said, 'I am the way'. I am the way to the truth and resurrection. Do you want to have eternal life? Then don't lie about God's Word. Teach it as written on a level that all people can understand. Gently, firmly and certainly even children must know what that parable meant. The parable of the sower, and Christ explains it in a manner in which even a child can understand it. They can begin to understand the controversy and the war we have between Satan and the seed of the woman. That is to say Christ and the children of God.*

There will yet be one more time that Satan will take an opportunity to destroy that woman through which Christ would come. We'll find it in the 6th chapter of this Book of Genesis. Again, I make no apology for God's Word! It's very easy for you to check out the Hebrew by the materials that I have submitted to you. God's Word is true - it's simple - it's wholesome and it's good. You never have to make any apologies for it. It brings about clarity, understanding and a happy life along with peace of mind. And eternal life. It is written - and it shall come to pass exactly as it is written! That first prophecy written in this book hasn't completely happened yet - but it's going to. (Satan did bruise (pierce) Christ's heel at the crucifixion) But...God will bruise Satan's head before it's over. IT IS WRITTEN!!

CHAPTER 4

Now, let's just get this straight coming out of the gate. You're gonna find that Chapter 4 gives Cain's genealogy...and you will find that Chapter 5 gives Adam's genealogy. Why then is Cain not in Adam's genealogy? Because he's not of his genes. God's Word is perfect...from the manuscripts. They are complete and had Cain been of Adam's genes - he would have been in Adam's genealogy. But, he's not - because he wasn't. It's not too difficult to grasp. We know what happened in the last lecture by the seduction of Eve and the conception. If there's something you don't understand - just put it on the shelf and stay along with us. God's Word always flows from the Old to the New Testament.

Genesis 4:1 *"And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD." Now, you must remember that they are innocent. To say 'a man from the Lord' is ish ish Yahveh - the word 'Cain' means possession. Abel, in the Hebrew tongue means 'breath of vapor'. It's thought that he was called Abel because his lifespan was so short that it passed as a vapor. Is that the real reason? I don't know, but it sounds logical.*

Genesis 4:2 *"And she again bare his brother Abel. (I repeat, she again bare his brother Abel) And Abel was a keeper of the sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground." We have a strange arrangement here because it was Adam that God created to till the soil. And here we have Cain, which is not of his genes, tilling the soil and Abel, a keeper of sheep. Many people misunderstand this. We know that conception took place in the prior chapter and here we have another conception from Adam. Not understanding the word 'again' as it is used here. She AGAIN bare his brother Abel...I want you to look at this word in the Hebrew. It's 'yaw-saf'...Strong's #3254: a primitive root; to add or augment - often adverbial, to continue to do a thing. Basically, it means to continue.*

Now, if she gives birth to Cain and she continues in labor - what does that mean? It means that she continued in the labor of delivering Cain - and delivered Abel. They were twins, but not by the same pregnancy. Identical twins are conceived in one conception...one pregnancy. They are both in the same bag of waters. Whereas twins that are not identical are two separate pregnancies that happen at two separate times - and they are in separate bags of water. Anyone that has a hang-up about this, talk to your medical doctor. And he or she will assure that this is correct. There are many records of someone having fraternal twins of two separate races. It's not a medical mystery. I'm not saying that fraternal twins are of two different fathers (but some are)-

but two conceptions. So what do we have here? We have a set of twins, of which Cain is not of Adams genealogy.

Genesis 4:3 *“And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD,” Note this very carefully. This is a religious act. It’s time for the sacrificial offerings to be offered to Almighty God. Cain simply brings an offering - it doesn’t say of his first-fruits. I see no love whatsoever involved in Cain having given this offering. You can pretty much rest assured that it wasn’t the best of his crop.*

Genesis 4:4 *“And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock (here we see that Abel brought of his first-fruits - his very best. Within this you see love in this religious act ... that is to say of loving our Father) and of the fat thereof. (This really pleased our Father) And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:” He did not respect Cain’s offering. Now - watch this next verse very carefully.*

Genesis 4:5 *“But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth (he was angry), and his countenance fell.” His countenance - his face - just drops down to nothing. He has a problem.*

Genesis 4:6 *“And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? And why is thy countenance fallen?” God knew - but He wanted Cain to admit it.*

Genesis 4:7 *“If thou doest well (this could be translated ‘if you were really honest), shalt thou not be accepted? (If you had done what was right, do you think your gift would not have been accepted?) And if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.” This loses a little bit in the translation. It should read ‘If you do not well (And Cain hadn’t...he didn’t give the first-fruits...he didn’t give his best) - sin waits crouching as a beast at the door to pursue you. This even goes back to the prophecy given in the prior chapter - ‘I will put enmity between your seed and her seed. We see here the beginning of the conflict between the seed of the woman and the seed of the serpent.*

Genesis 4:8 *And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.” The more ancient manuscripts say that Cain talked to Abel and convinced him to go into the field, which is obvious that this was the case. And here we have the war beginning between the seeds. It is an amazing thing that man will war over religion. That’s what started this conflict...the offerings to Almighty God.*

Now, lest someone gets nervous, you must always have a second witness in God's Word before you can accept a thing. If God seemingly gives you a thought, it must be backed up or second witnessed in more than one place. You must have at least two witnesses before you can be fairly comfortable with a translation. So, it really helps if you have the Word of Christ on a thing - from His own mouth - recorded in the New Testament. Turn with me to Matthew 23 - and we're going to take Christ's own words concerning this one Cain...this murderer. It's in several places, but we're only going to cover a couple that will give a second witness to what we have just said concerning the pregnancies and the conception.

Matthew 23:33 - *Christ is talking to the Kenites, of course - that means the the sons of Cain. "Ye serpents (who was the seed of the serpent? You know it was Cain's children. Who are they - Kenites), ye generation (offspring) of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?"*

Matthew 23:34 *"Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city."*

Matthew 23:35 *Listen carefully - this is why we came here. "That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, who ye slew between the temple and the altar." So, you see - from the first murderer - the murder of Abel - if it's going to fall on the serpent's seed, verse 33 - ye serpents - ye offspring of vipers - that all the righteous blood - you'll be found guilty of it from Abel to this time. We know that Cain was of that seed of the serpent. Let's take another New Testament - in the Epistles of John chapter 3 - and let's pick up more proof ...*

I John 3:11 *"For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning (what beginning? - Genesis), that we should love one another."*

I John 3:12 *"Not as Cain, (I repeat - not as Cain) who was of (this is progeny...offspring) that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous." So, we see that Abel, although there's very little written about it, we know that he loved Almighty God because of his offering. Whereas Cain- just the opposite. Being of that wicked one - did not possess that righteousness within his soul.*

Now, God makes salvation available to all His children. But this Cain and his offspring, as we will find - as his genealogy is written in this chapter - has been recorded

throughout and I can think of other places - John 8:44 for instance - I can think of the Book of Jude - speaking of Cain's lack of righteousness. Christ speaks of Cain's father - the devil. Let's just go to John 8:44...this is where people that call themselves of Judah - but were lying - because they are of Cain. Listen carefully....

John 8:44 *"Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning (who was the first murderer? Well, let's see - we just read it. It was Cain. He slew his brother Abel), and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own; for he is a liar and the father of it."* So, there you have it. Don't expect too much other than lies from them.

I know that it's difficult for many preachers to teach the truth because of the controversy. But, I will have it no other way. I don't care how controversial it is - if it's God's Word, it's always positive in the end. And without knowing the parables, you're not going to understand much anyway. You're kinda walking around in a daze without knowing the truth. I dislike labels because there is only one Word of God - and to teach anything other than that is a waste of time. When God's Word is so to the point and so true. And gives us an understanding of this world that we can live with.

So, the war of the seeds began. The first murder has happened...

Genesis 4:9 *"And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?"* What a liar. Even lying to God Himself. He knew where Abel was.

Genesis 4:10 *"And (God speaking) He said what hast thou done? The voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground."* In the manuscripts, this word 'blood' is plural - meaning 'bloods'. Why? All the children that Abel would have given birth to - those genes also cried out from the ground. When you murder someone - you don't just murder that person - but you also murder all the offspring that would have come from that person. That's why murder must always be settled with the Father - not with man.

Genesis 4:11 *"And now art thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;"* He had bloody hands.

Genesis 4:12 *"When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth."* Even to this day...you will never find a Kenite farmer unless he owns the farm and hires the

labor done by someone else. Because even to this day, the ground will not yield her fruit to them. They always have to hire someone else to do the actual farming. Therefore, they became vagabonds and builders of cities because that's the only way they could survive.

Genesis 4:13 “And Cain said unto the LORD, my punishment is greater than I can bear.”

Genesis 4:14 “Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, that every one that findeth me shall slay me.”

Now, stop and think here. Who and where are all these peoples that would slay him? You see, Cain knew the 6th day creation was out there. All the races. Quite contrary to what some with lack of knowledge, do not teach today. He knew how many peoples were out there, and he knew he would be unpopular.

Genesis 4:15 “And the LORD said unto him, Therefore whosoever slayeth Cain, vengeance shall be taken on him sevenfold. And the LORD set a mark upon Cain, lest any finding him should kill him.” *And here you have the original and the beginning of the mark of the beast. To understand the mark of the beast, you must count - as it is written in Revelation 13:18. The word ‘count’ is a Greek word that means to count my enumeration with stones worn smooth over a long period of time - meaning from this day in the garden up until this day. A continuous counting and keeping familiar with the seed of Cain - or better said, the Kenites.*

This is why the only two churches that Christ found no fault in - Smyrna and Philadelphia - in Revelation chapters 2 and 3. They had one thing in common - and if you're attending a church that does not teach this same thing that these two churches taught - which Christ was happy with - then I'm sorry - you're back on the back burner, friend. Those two churches taught who the Kenites were...that claim to be of our brother Judah, but were of the synagogue of Satan. You can read it in Revelation 2:9 and 3:9. I'm sorry - this is the way that it is, and I make no apologies for God's Word.

Genesis 4:16 “And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.” *Here's a clue to where it is - it's east! Toward the orient. Asia.*

Genesis 4:17 “And Cain knew his wife; and she conceived, and bare Enoch: and he builded a city, and called the name of the city, after the name of his son, Enoch.” *He was a builder of cities. It's interesting that Iscariot, as in Judas Iscariot -*

means 'builder of cities'. Did you ever think about that? Or did you even know it? I don't know. You should know the truth and be able to discern spiritually - who has that spiritual mark and who doesn't. You need to know your enemy. The war between the seeds. Spiritual enemies - you bet! Do we have to be afraid of them? Not in the least! Christ gave us power over all our enemies.

You will note - and I will mention in passing that the genealogy of Cain will bear practically the same names as the genealogy of Adam. This is God's cool way of telling you - you had better know - because names will throw you. You had better keep the Key of David, which lets you determine the difference between the seed lines of the serpent and of Adam. And of other races.

So, how did we have those people over in Nod - that he could take a wife from? Haven't heard much about Nod. Well, it really has if you've understood chapter 1. He married one of the people of the 6th day creation. No problem. God's Word is perfect and complete. If some preacher tells you just to have faith - because nobody knows - but we do know. If you're a student of God's Word - you do know!! Don't buy into that stuff. It may seem that I'm being a little tough on churches today - but it's time somebody got tough on them. God's gonna get a lot tougher.

Genesis 4:18 *"And unto Enoch was born Irad (means fleet): and Irad begat Mehujael (means smitten by God): and Mehujael begat Methusael (means man of God): and Methusael begat Lamech (Noah's father was named Lamech - but it was much different than this one)."*

Genesis 4:19 *"And Lamech took unto him two wives: the name of the one was Adah (means beautiful), and the name of the other Zillah (means tanned)."*

Genesis 4:20 *"And Adah bare Jabal: (we've got a lot of 'bal's here. Ever heard of Baal worship) he was the father of such as dwell in tents, and of such as have cattle."*

Genesis 4:21 *"And his brother's name was Jubal: he was the father of all such as handle the harp and organ." Musicians*

Genesis 4:22 *"And Zillah, she also bare Tubalcain, an instructor of every artificier in brass and iron: and the sister of Tubalcain was Naamah (means loveliness...come into my little web)."*

Genesis 4:23 “And Lamech said unto his wives, Adah and Zillah, hear my voice; ye wives of Lamech, hearken unto my speech: for I have slain a man to my wounding, and a young man to my hurt.” *He’s a murderer! And bragging about it.*

Genesis 4:24 “If Cain shall be avenged sevenfold, truly Lamech seventy and sevenfold.” *He’s actually bragging about their lack of care in serving God. Bragging and boasting about being murderers. Let me ask you something. If Adam and Eve, being formed by God... totally innocent, where did all this wickedness slip in here from? Do I need to tell you? I think not. I think you can figure it out for yourselves. There’s a snake in the woodpile somewhere.*

This concludes Cain’s genealogy. Now you’re going to be given Adam’s - sharpen up...

Genesis 4:25 “And Adam knew his wife again; and she bare a son, and called his name Seth (*means compensation. She’s being compensated for losing Abel*): For God, said she, hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew.”.

Genesis 4:26 “And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the LORD.” *Now, I want to tell you about this word ‘began’ here. It’s meaning is to profane God. I just did a single study on Enoch that documents all this. I would recommend it as a supplemental study for these chapters. It will help you be better founded. As it sounds in the English language, it sounds like they were calling on God to praise him. But no, they are profaning Him - turning to other ways of belief. That’s why Enoch was translated because of his love and truthfulness to Almighty God.*

CHAPTER 5

Listen carefully and let God’s Word speak to you without allowing anything you have heard in the past (from man) to change God’s Word. You just heard the genealogy of Cain. Listen to this...

Genesis 5:1 “This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him;”

Genesis 5:2 “Male and female created He them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.” *This is the 6th day creation.*

I want to stress again - when the word Adam is utilized without the article, it means 'mankind'...or 'human beings'.

Now He comes to ha-Adam, with the article, whereas you would know that's 'the-Adam' through which Christ would come. Here is his generation...

Genesis 5:3 *“And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth:”* Do you find Cain listed here? No, you won't. Do you know why? This is a chronological giving of the genes of Adam. Why isn't Cain here? He isn't of Adam's genes. He was not Adam's son. It's very difficult to accept that. But, if you can't accept it...as Jesus said concerning the parable of the tares, which the wicked one planted in the world - if you don't understand this - you won't accept any of the parables....Mark 4.

So, it's up to you. Let God's Word speak - He gave you a brain and He expects you to use it. Because there will be no church, organization, label or denomination standing between you and God on Judgment Day and you will be judged by His Word. Are you familiar with it? Don't you think you should take it into consideration and check out for yourself? Your eternal soul depends on it. 'But, I was told all I had to do was believe.' Believe what? Believe in the true Christ or the false christ. Follow the children of Cain or follow the children of God? You're lacking if you don't know which is which. Think about it. I'm not trying to frighten anyone. This King James version was placed here by King James, one of the kings of the 10 Lost Tribes of Israel, whereby you would have God's Word at your disposal. And it is written in a simple language that even a child can understand. Think about it - God loves you!

After finishing chapter 4, we learn that there are two seed lines. Chapter 4 was the seed line of Cain. Now, in chapter 5, we're going to have the seed line of Adam. Many might ask why are they not one in the same? Well, it's pretty obvious when Cain is not in Adam's genealogy. Genealogy means 'the genes of Adam'. If someone father's a child, that child has the genes of both parents. But, Cain didn't have Adam's genes. It's plain and everyone should grab on to that.

But, the important lesson that I want you to learn - I don't necessarily find genealogies very exciting. But this one could be exciting because of the nearness of names. Cain's genealogy has Jabal, Jubal and Tubal. These all come from the same prime in the Hebrew...meaning 'to flow'. And they all flowed right along. In the completion of the last lecture, it's stated that people began to call upon the name of the Lord. It loses a little bit in the Hebrew. The word is 'callal' (?) - which means to wound or to profane. They began to profane the name of the Lord. Why? Because they were already

beginning to intermix with the fallen angels - the Nephilim which we will get to in the next chapter.

Genesis 5:4 “And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters.” *He begat other children - but the line always goes with the eldest son.*

Genesis 5:5 “And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died.” *This would be exactly 120 years after God had placed the sentence that we will read of in the next chapter. He would only live 120 years, which is one of the lengths of a generation.*

Genesis 5:6 “And Seth lived an hundred and five years, and begat Enos (*means mortal man or frail*):” *The interesting thing - Seth, meaning compensation because Cain slew Abel, who would have been Adam’s firstborn.*

Genesis 5:7 “And Seth lived after he begat Enos eight hundred and seven years, and begat sons and daughters:”

Genesis 5:8 “And all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years: and he died.” *Note the longevity of these people and from this you can gather how man has polluted this earth. Not to mention the sentence that God placed upon them. It shows you that man has polluted this earth with toxins and poisons until there’s no way that a flesh body could hold together for eight or nine hundred years. With the state that our atmosphere, our waters are in at this time. Also the fact that man has sinned and pulled away from God in one form or another.*

Genesis 5:9 “And Enos lived ninety years, and begat Cainan:” *Cainan means possession.*

Genesis 5:10 “And Enos lived after he begat Cainan eight hundred and fifteen years, and begat sons and daughters:”

Genesis 5:11 “And all the days of Enos were nine hundred and five years: and he died.” *Remember that God said, ‘In the day that Adam sinned, would be the day that he would die. And a day with God is 1,000 years - and none of these ever lived that long.*

Genesis 5:12 ‘And Cainan lived seventy years, and begat Mahalaleel:” *Mahalaleel means ‘praise of God’. Cainan no doubt loved the Lord because he named this child,*

praise of God. Bear in mind, although it is not written, but becomes obvious from the Word that things are waxing worse and worse as years go by.

Genesis 5:13 “And Cainan lived after he begat Mahalaleel eight hundred and forty years, and begat sons and daughters:”

Genesis 5:14 “And all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years: and he died.”

Genesis 5:15 “And Mahalaleel lived sixty and five years, and begat Jared:” *Jared means descent.*

Genesis 5:16 “And Mahalaleel lived after he begat Jared eight hundred and thirty years, and begat sons and daughters:” *No doubt these were very large families.*

Genesis 5:17 “And all the days of Mahalaleel were eight hundred ninety and five years: and he died.”

Genesis 5:18 “And Jared lived an hundred sixty and two years, and he begat Enoch:” *Here we come to a real special person. Enoch can be translated ‘dedicated’ but it can also be translated ‘initiate or discipline’ because we know from his life - that he was a great one for discipline. In a sense, from the Book of Jude, we know that Enoch (this is not the son of Cain)...the son of Adam, and he was a prophet. This is important. Especially when his name is to ‘initiate’ a new way. To initiate a new discipline. So, we know that simply by the name and the things that happened to Enoch, and with him being a prophet - it says a great deal more than what is written. Up until this day, God walked with Adam and Eve and talked with them one on one - and they didn’t need a prophet. A prophet is one that God speaks to and then that prophet sounds a warning to the people. So, Enoch initiated a new way of thinking because God instructed him and walked with him. He was righteous, and well-disciplined. Whether or not you like it - you will find that all the people - both men and women - that God truly utilized were well disciplined people. Common people, yes. But disciplined to the ways of God. That is to say, God’s plan. Wanting to help fulfill what God wanted His children to do. To fulfill and bring about the completion which has been in progress from that day to this current day.*

We have to know and understand from his name and the events that happened - that we have quite a bit going on at this time - that the pulling away from God and the intermixing of the Nephelium, no doubt has already begun. From the last chapter, we know that the people talked against God instead of talking to Him. They polluted God’s

way. And here we have one of the men that God would send, Enoch - the initiator or the discipliner, who would begin to bring back in that warning. He brought in the discipline of God's Word.

The point that I want to make is the fairness of our Father. Don't think that before Noah's flood came that they weren't warned. Because there were prophets sent to them. It's very easily documented. As we get closer to the flood time, I'll make it clear.

Genesis 5:19 "And Jared lived after he begat Enoch eight hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:" *This 8th day creation was growing considerably.*

Genesis 5:20 "And all the days of Jared were nine hundred sixty and two years: and he died."

Genesis 5:21 "And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah:" *This is an interesting name in the Hebrew. It means 'darts' - hitting the mark. But, having a father like Enoch - he was probably very disciplined.*

Genesis 5:22 "And Enoch (listened carefully) walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:"

Genesis 5:23 "And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years:" *What happened? He did not die.*

Genesis 5:24 "And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him." *He was translated...transformed. So, we see the goodness, and was his faithfulness that brought this to pass. He was righteous. He must have been some kind of a prophet.*

Genesis 5:25 "And Methuselah lived an hundred eighty and seven years, and begat Lamech:" *Lamech means 'powerful'. Methuselah was the oldest man that ever lived. But, I want to go back into the genealogy of Cain to show you a little difference here. In Cain's genealogy, we find Methusael - with 'el' being the title 'god', whereas in Adam's genealogy, we find Methuselah - I will say 'yah' - where you have the sacred name. Not title - but His sacred name. But, yet at the same time, I feel that God sends you a special message in the fact that many of the names - example Cain had an Enoch and a Lamech and Methusael (close to Methuselah). What is God telling you? Two separate genealogies - but someone might think that the families were mixed up. Not so. It's God's way of telling you to learn how to translate for yourself to grasp the meaning of the names. But, at the same time, the most important fact is to follow the*

gene. Because it would be through this gene that we're now studying (ha-adam) that Christ, the Savior of the world, being the only begotten of God - would come through this genealogy.

The point of knowing (in the flesh) who you're worshipping - is the major point of this life. To decide whether you're going to love God or Satan. Love is the one thing that God will never force you to do - otherwise it would be fake love. He won't have it - it's out of His line of thought. It would be false, and He wants nothing false - including children. You're either real - genuine - have faith I could say something here - and I will. Enoch was a prophet, but how good of a prophet was he? How many people did he convert? But, don't judge. Seed-planting is a long-drawn out process. No one has died yet and no one has been judged yet. Until the end of the Millennium, you can't put your ducks in a row to who is going into the lake of fire. God's plan is a long plan - He's very patient. And, as we have studied in II Peter 3 - God is long-suffering. And it's His will that all come to repentance.

Watch the names, yes, but better yet - there will be many times that you could be deceived because names are also used in geographical areas. We'll take the case of Moses' father-in-law for instance. Jethro was a Kenite. But, he really wasn't - because he only lived in the land of the Kenites. Watch the names but it's important to keep up with the genes.

Genesis 5:26 "And Methuselah lived after he begat Lamech seven hundred eighty and two years, and begat sons and daughters."

Genesis 5:27 "And all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred sixty and nine years: and he died."

Genesis 5:28 "And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son:" Here we come to the end of this genealogy because he would be the father of Noah. Then we open into a new time period. It's important that you know that Noah was definitely a son of Adam. (Ha-adam).

Genesis 5:29 "And he called his name Noah, saying, This same shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed." Lamech expected big things from Noah to bring comfort from the land that God had cursed. And Noah did not let him down. That discipline that came from his great-grandfather, Enoch - as it was passed down...that truth no doubt was maintained. From the man that initiated the discipline - to the man with the darts straight to the point - To this one that was powerful - Lamech. To the one that is

comforter. Noah means 'rest or comforter'. We see in a sense that hoping for or looking forward in this genealogy - that THE ONE, Messiah - that would be the comforter was even within this man's name. What's in a name? A lot. But, at the same time - be sure you have the right key or you just might get it into the wrong lock.

Genesis 5:30 *"And Lamech lived after he begat Noah five hundred ninety and five years, and begat sons and daughters:" And these large families continue. By this time, there would have been a large population on the earth. This genealogy as well as the 6th day creation.*

Genesis 5:31 *"And all the days of Lamech were seven hundred seventy and seven years: and he died."*

Genesis 5:32 *"And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem, Ham and Japeth."* *I want to read this again - Noah was five hundred years old before he had his first child. He was being very specific wasn't he? You see, things had grown so bad and that's one of the reasons why God translated Enoch. It was deteriorating to a point that these fallen angels had intermixed. And in the next chapter, we'll really get into this. Since I want to do it justice, we won't go very far into it today...because it's a subject that you must absorb and understand. It's not commonly taught. Why? Because it's controversial. But, it's God's Word and without it, you are handicapped to understand the rest of His Word. You must know and understand because much of the New Testament has reference to the chapter we're about to study. Even to the point that it would be the likeness of the return of Christ.*

So, we see that things had deteriorated tremendously. And I have little doubt in my mind that Noah had to look a long time for a wife that hadn't already participated in these hybrids that were becoming plentiful. It's not talked about until chapter 6 - so how did Noah know - because they had a prophet - Enoch. It was bad enough that God just pulled him out of it. God was very disappointed with man at this time. When He took Enoch it was like He pulled the plug on morality. Especially when you had people from a different time walking the earth with them.

I want to say one other thing. Shem, Ham and Japeth - Shem wasn't the first born. They are reversed. Japeth was the first born...and then Ham and then Shem. Shem was the youngest. We'll say more about this as we go along - but the youngest was actually chosen. Why? We'll see as we proceed.

CHAPTER 6

I hope you've noted that we've gone back into the Hebrew quite a bit in these first 5 chapters. It does you well to know what the manuscripts actually say. Always stick with God's Word and disregard what man teaches. Go by God's Word and you'll never go wrong. And He is the one that will judge you. God speaks in a simple way - a way that's very natural...whereby we can better understand.

Now, we come to this 6th chapter, and we're going to be dealing with fallen angels. Many people skip over this chapter and it's discussed very little by most churches. When I teach God's Word - chapter by chapter and verse by verse, I will never skip a chapter because of controversy. We're not too nice for God, we take His Word as it is written. What I teach is my opinion - do with it what you like. So, here we are with Noah and his three sons. From the time of Enoch - and even before - wickedness had been increasing among men. Why? You'll find out in this chapter.

Genesis 6:1 *"And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them," The word 'man' here is singular with the article - so we're talking about Adam. ha-adam.*

Genesis 6:2 *"That the sons of God (Underline this in your mind) saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose."* *The sons of God are always - always when used in this sense - speaking of angelic beings. Many people get all uptight when we talk about angels cohabiting with woman. You've got to remember - there are three parts to bodies - soul, body and spirit. Angelic spirits can visit us at this time, but they also have a body that partook of angels food (manna). It sustained even the flesh body for 40 years in the wilderness. God made them to look exactly as we do. So, the body make up for this age - this earth age and this heaven age - is as it appears. We're going to document what these sons of God - what were they supposed to do? God created the woman to bear children - that is to say giving each entity an opportunity to pass through this earth age - to love God or Satan. These beings saw that the women were fair (beautiful) and they lusted after them. And rather than to be born of woman - they seduced her - took her to wife.*

I want you to think seriously about these sons of God. You are fortunate if you have a Companion Bible because there is an appendix on this subject as well as their offspring. Appendix 23, 25 and 26. Let's go to the Book of Job 38 where for 38 chapters, he has listened to his three friends - and God finally said to Job in verse 2 - He said, 'Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?' He had been listening to these three knuckleheads and they were totally without knowledge. God asked him why he was listening to them - and said 'Why don't you look at Me?' This is where Job fell

down. He didn't consider the greatness of our Father. God told him to stand up and act like a man...He asked him a question...'Where were you when I laid the foundations of this earth?' "Where were you when I put things in order?" That takes man and makes him a little bit smaller. It's very humbling.

Job 38:6 "Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? (God is asking Job - what holds this earth in its place?) Or who laid the corner stone thereof;"

Job 38:7 "When the morning stars (sharpen up) sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?" It was a happy time before Satan rebelled. The whole host - all the souls were there. They rejoiced and they were happy. Then after Satan rebelled - things took on a different complexion. Let's go to the Book of Jude - remember the angels that were holding there for destruction? Do you know why God had already judged them to destruction? It's written here. It's the same angels as are called the sons of God. Absorb and listen to this...Let the Word speak for itself...

Jude 1:6 "And the angels which kept not their first estate (heaven), but left their own habitation (and came to this earth and took wives), he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day." Their death sentence is sealed. Remember Enoch (lineage of Adam) - that was transformed - he's mentioned here also, so that you know we're talking about Genesis 6.

Jude 1:14 "And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints," This is exactly how it will be at the end when Satan and his angels are kicked out onto this earth. So, you bet, they are the sons of God. But they were fallen angels. They're mentioned more than one time - before we finish this study in Genesis - you will find them called rephaim. Different lecture for a different time - because there was a second influx of these angelic beings.

Let's return to the 6th chapter - the sons of God are angelic beings that left their habitation. That's why they are called Nephilim.

Genesis 6:3 "And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh (the 'he' here is emphatic because the man with the article is emphatic - the Adam through whom Christ would come. Don't ever think for a moment that Satan did not know which people it would be through which woman would give birth to Messiah. He knew and he was trying again to destroy that woman. The 'he' makes it emphatic but he was also flesh): yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty

years.”. Noah would have been 810 years old when this was given. And 120 years later he died at 930 years old.

This is another length of generations that He gives man.

Genesis 6:4 “There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God (remember who they are) came into the daughters of men, and they bare children to them (do I have to tell you what was going on?), the same became mighty men which were of old (they had the ability inasmuch as the angels knew what happened in the first earth age), **men of renown.”** I want to take that word ‘giants’ as it is used here and go to the Hebrew if we may. I want you to know what it means, so that no man can strip you of truth. It’s ‘nephyl’ or nephil’ It means ‘properly a feller, i.e. a bully or tyrant. Strongs #5303 - prime of #5307. Let’s go to that prime #5307 ‘naphal’ - to fall - and these fallen angels fell to this earth. Be locked in and know exactly what happened there - who these angelic beings were - and how God in the first 4 verses in the great Book of Jude - already has them in holding after the flood. Whereby when they are cast out with Satan, (Revelation 12:7) - their number 7,000 - will die instantly. (Revelation 11) They will have fulfilled their purpose in testing men.

So, it’s good for you to go into the Hebrew and learn - in case you’ve not studied with us before. It’s simply brought forth in a Strong’s Concordance. This and a King James Bible allows the English reader to check out the languages - to see if what they have been told is true or not.

Genesis 6:5 “And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth (in other words, this just didn’t start in the 6th chapter...they began to talk against the Living God), and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.” It went on night and day. When it’s bad enough that God can only destroy the ungodly misfits with a flood. It was bad - with the progeny of woman and the giants.

What you want to realize - in Matthew 24, Jesus said, ‘Hey, you want to know what it’s going to be like when I return to this earth? It’s going to be just like it was in the days of Noah.’ They’re going to be giving and taking in marriage - and dancing. With who? The fallen angels. This happens in Revelation 12:7 when Michael casts them out onto the earth. Defacto! Not just in Satan’s spirit - but walking again on this earth. God releases Satan to test this final generation. He will come as ‘super Jesus’. The false christ. Antichrist. It’s gonna happen. It would be for this same reason that Paul would say in I Corinthians 11:10, that women should keep their heads covered because of the

angels. *They're coming back, friend! I don't say this to frighten anyone - but it's what God's Word states. It shall happen.*

Genesis 6:6 *"And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart." In other words, before this - man had never been flesh. Now, in a sense he was an animal - and certainly, animalistic traits came forth. When you put the supernatural among them. But, you haven't seen anything yet. Wait until the supernatural begins to work their 'miracles', as it is written in Revelation 13:11...when the false one comes.*

Genesis 6:7 *"And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them." In other words, ultimately this will come to pass - when we change into spiritual bodies. When the lion lays down with a lamb and the bear eats hay like a cow. This naturally requires a change. This will happen at the 7th trump.*

Genesis 6:8 *"But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD." Noah - meaning 'comforter' in the Hebrew tongue.*

Genesis 6:9 *"These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God." I want to repeat, 'Noah walked with God'. The word 'perfect' means here - he was without spot or blemish. And here you can see the coming through of the Christ child - that He had to be a sacrifice without spot or blemish. So, we see that woman was saved - to bring forth Messiah. Satan fell through trying to destroy this generation. I want you to know what 'generations' means - it doesn't mean generation as we think of it. Hebrew 'towledah' - Strong's #8435 - - descent, i.e. family, (figuratively) history. from the prime root of #3205 - 'yalad' a primitive root: to bear young: causatively, to begat; medically, to act as a midwife, specifically to show lineage. Genes, pedigree, lineage. I would hope that you would take your Strong's and check it out for yourself. Always go to the prime so that you have the foundation of the very word itself. Meaning within him, his sons and his wife - they had not inter-mixed with the fallen angels or anyone that had. They still had a spotless pedigree. I know this makes some people nervous - but that's what it means. Their lineage. Satan tried to destroy that lineage. Because it would be this man (ha-adam) through Noah that would bring forth the Christ child. Satan wanted to destroy it from the very beginning.*

So, we see that we have one man that has not inter-mixed - no hybrids in his family. He was without spot or blemish whereby through those genes could come the Messiah -

the Christ child - who would be sacrificed without spot or blemish - for all our sins. Otherwise, we would be in sad shape today...without a perfect One to pay for our wicked sins. A flesh body does sin. I hope that no one has a problem with seeing what has happened in these verses. What was going on that displeased God.

Genesis 6:10 *“And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham and Japeth.” These births are not in order and I’ll explain further in this Book of Genesis.*

Genesis 6:11 *“The earth was also corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.” It was bad - and with those supernatural entities - Satan almost succeeded.*

Genesis 6:12 *“And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.” This takes in the 6th day creation and 8th day creation - all flesh. All the races.*

Genesis 6:13 *“And God said unto Noah, the end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.” Better translated - destroy them from the earth. Don’t think God has a short memory - this will come to pass at the 7th trump, the human part of this will take place. At the end of the Millennium - the rest of it will. That is to say the animal kingdom.*

Genesis 6:14 *“Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.” This word, pitch, is the only word in the Hebrew language used for atonement. It means to cover it over and protect it - whereby it will save you from the flood. I believe this particular word is used here as a covering in the end times - that we have in Christ for the flood of the end times mentioned in Revelation 12, which is not a flood of water. I repeat - not a flood of water. But, a flood of lies that this same destroyer, Satan, who brought this wickedness into the world - will flood the religions with lies - to get them to believe a lie. And you had better be covered over - pitched over - in the ark of the end times - which is the say the truth - with Christ to protect you - or you will be in the middle of those lies of deception. Listening to antichrist saying he’s come to ‘rapture’ you out...before the true Messiah returns. It’s your decision, friend. I hope you follow God’s plan.*

Genesis 6:15 *“And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: the length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.” You’re gonna have 3 decks - 10’ for each deck. It is believed by some scholars that a cubit would be anywhere from 17.5” up to the sacred cubit, which*

was about 25". You can multiply 300 x either 17.5 or 25 and see that you have a pretty long ship here.

Genesis 6:16 "A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt set in the side thereof; with lower, second and third stories shalt thou make it." You know - spiritually speaking, there are 3 levels. There are often 3 levels in God's teachings. There are 3 earth ages. There are 3 in the Godhead. It's amazing how perfect God's plan is. Even in this ark of salvation, we see these facts are God's plan - always perfect.

Genesis 6:17 "And, behold, I, even I (*this makes it emphatic*), do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein is the breath of life, from under heaven; and every thing that is in the earth shall die."

Genesis 6:18 "But with thee will I establish my covenant (*my contract*); thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee." Remember, they had perfect genes from Adam. They hadn't mixed - there were no hybrids among them. They were all Adamic, whereby Christ could come of that family. That makes 8 Adamic souls. Does this mean everyone else dies? No, because the Kenites and other races are still with us. How do we manage this?

Genesis 6:19 "And of every living thing of all flesh (*what does this mean? Every living thing of all flesh? Well, are the Kenites flesh? Yes, of course they are. Are the other races flesh? Yes, of course they are. They are living today*), two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female." In other words, you will pick and take into the ark two of all flesh - two of all races, including Kenites.

Genesis 6:20 "Of fowls after their kind, and of cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the earth after his kind, two of every sort shall come unto thee, to keep them alive."

Genesis 6:21 "And take thou unto thee of all food that is eaten (*consumed by the various species*), and thou shalt gather it to thee; and it shall be for food for thee, and for them." God always plans ahead. Do you want to think about your ark of the end times? We know we have a 5-month period. Surely everybody has their pantry well supplied for at least 30 days. Especially when they can't do any buying or selling.

The whole purpose is to have God's Elect delivered up, as it is written in Mark 13, when this false Christ as Christ says in this same chapter. Not that 'maybe' the false Christ

would come - but that certainly he would come...before Christ Himself would return. Many of this generation are going to live through it. God has foretold you all things in His Word - to guide us through this time.

Genesis 6:22 “This did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.” Do you want to know a verse that will really bring you blessings? We just read it. Do you want to know why Noah found grace - it didn't mean he as perfect...it was only his pedigree (lineage) that was perfect. He found grace, which is an unmerited favor.

Noah obeyed God! And when you obey Him, He is going to bless you. You might be struggling with angelic beings cohabiting with women. You've never heard such a thing. Well then, you've never read God's Word. You've never read the Bible. You've never been taught the Bible if you haven't heard it before. It's brought forth here even in the English (language) whereby even a child can understand it. And the 2nd witnesses are so plentiful throughout the Word of God - of the actual events and what transpired.

Why would God kill 7,000 angelic beings on the day that the Two Witnesses rise from the streets of Jerusalem? They blew their chance - as it is written in the Book of Jude - where they left their habitation. In other words, they were trying (through Satan) to totally disrupt the plan of salvation of the Living God. It's that simple. It's beautiful. I do not find God's Word boring or uninteresting - I find it fascinating. There has been much mythology written by other peoples (other than Christianity) and students of the Torah. Much mythology concerning the giants - there are records today that people (scholars) know - but it's just easier not to talk about it. They don't want to rock the boat. But, if you don't cover your boat over well with atonement - and Christ's truth - your boat is probably going to sink. I'm talking about your Christian boat of life. Lifeboat! You're not going to make it if you're not armed with the gospel armor. And the very thing that keeps your britches on is the truth. If you don't have the truth - you don't have a belt - and you're going to lose your britches. I hope you accept this truth - to know how it began in the beginning - whereby you can also understand the end.
